c. No interest will be claimed against the EMD.

d) In case of L₁ manufacturer / tenderer, the EMD should be refunded to the bidder on successful completion of supply to the concerned Department as per their requirement. However, the EMD of L₁ supplier will be forfeited in case he does not accept the supply order / not supplied the material within specified time.

 - ii. After receipt of indent from CDAO / DDH / PD Soil Conservation, MD, OAIC will supply the material at block headquarter with the help of the Manufacturer or their authorized dealer.
